

Greece is the birthplace of great people and the Olympic Games.

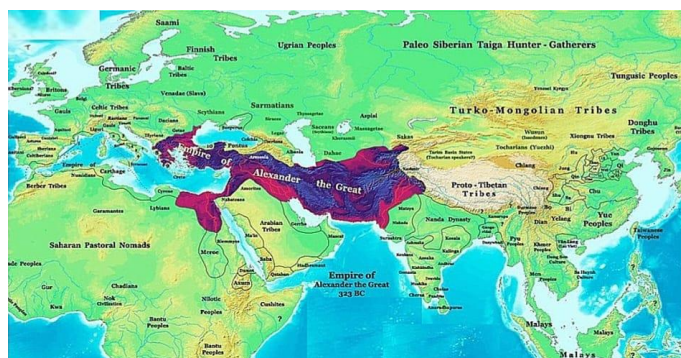
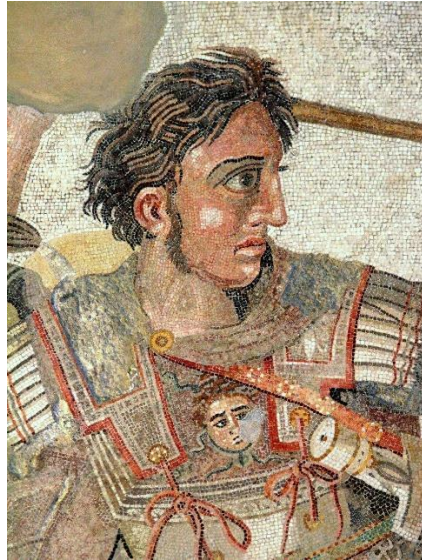
Greece is an ancient and great country.
